

QUINTREX 450 HORNET TROPHY



The Quintrex 450 Hornet Trophy has proved to be one of the most enduring models in the giant 72-model Quintrex range. There is a very good reason for its popularity, too – it really is a boat for its time, and when it's time for a new boat, it doesn't get much better than this. Introducing one of the most popular all round fishing boats in Australia: folks, meet the 2008 450 Hornet Trophy.

People talk about things being “in the zone” or “in the pocket” but whatever the cliché, most of them were written about the 450 Hornet Trophy. Not that there's anything wrong with the other models, either, but there's just a particular formulaic magic about the 450 Hornet that keeps it on top of the sales chart month after month, year after year.
