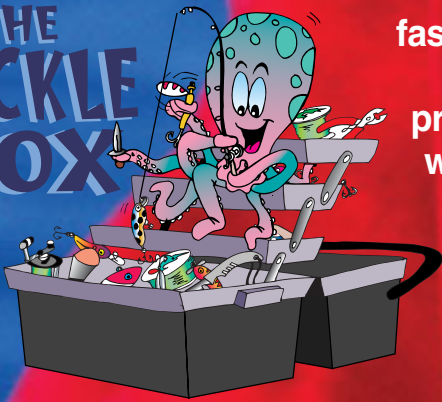


THE TACKLE BOX
