

Angler 215 Walkaround



Created by the talented hands of craftsman Steve Peake, the Angler 21 was conceived as the Archer 650 by Skippercraft, before Bundaberg boatbuilder Greg Franks took over the project. He moved the moulds to Bundy, contracted a delighted Steve Peake as design and building consultant, and has now swung this outstanding craft into full production.

The Angler 21 is a walkaround with an unusually big cabin. It has full length berths and easy sitting headrooom. A big, deep s.d. cockpit for serious bluewater fishermen, plus an excellent live bait tank set-up, and fish lockers set into the sole. Packed with poured foam, the Angler is unsinkable, and features an exceptionally soft-riding, quiet hull, combing a centre 'plank', variable deadrise deep vee and chine venting - truly as close to the known state of design in production craft of this class, you will find. Perfect with 175-200hp outboards.
